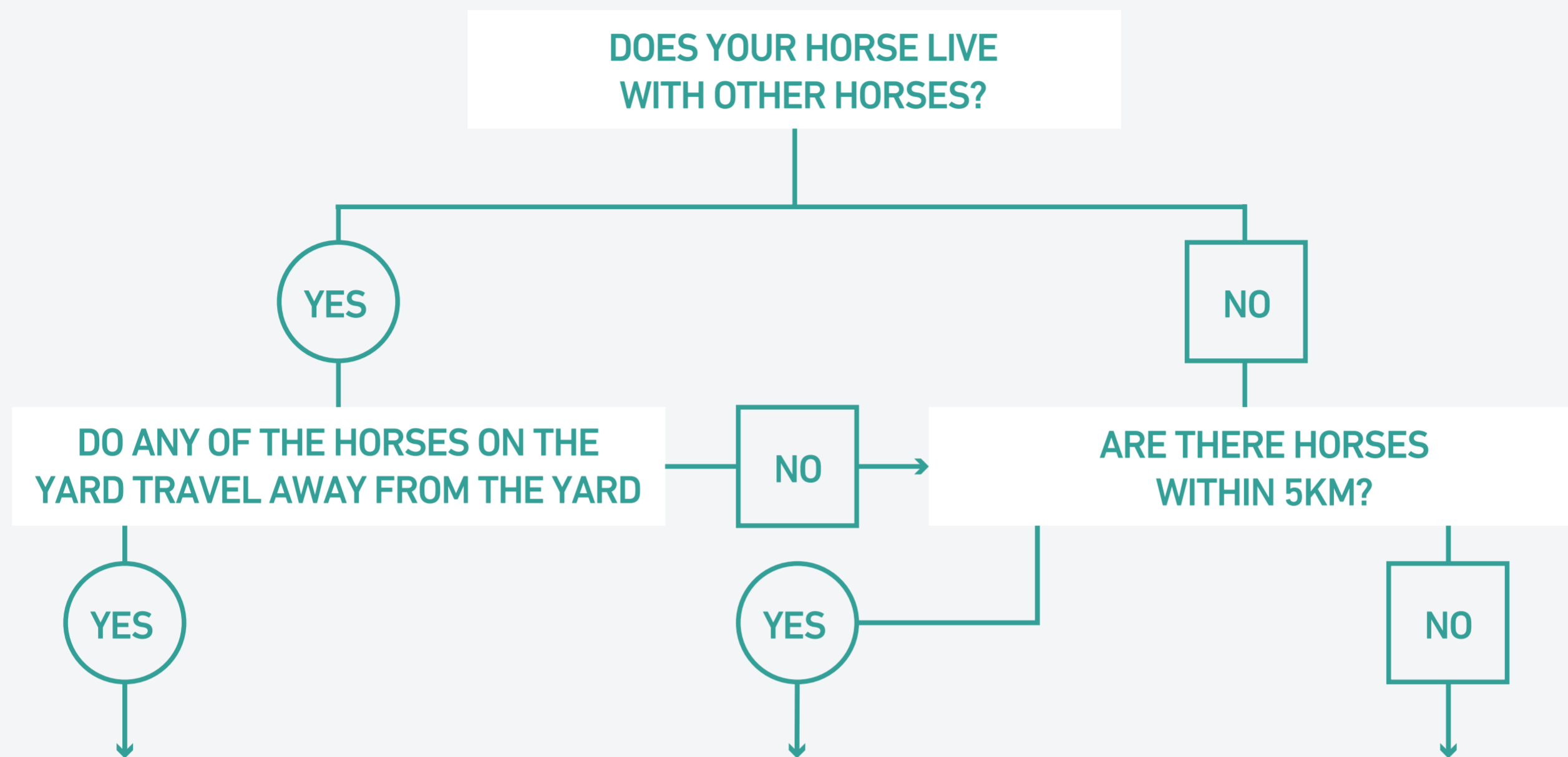




# WHAT'S YOUR RISK?



Even if your horse doesn't leave the yard, others do. This increases the risk of infectious diseases such as strangles and influenza entering the yard and potentially infecting your horse.

Equine Influenza can travel up to 5km so even if no horses leave the yard if there are other horses in the local area there is still a risk of influenza.

The risk of strangles is less if good biosecurity measures are in place to stop people/vehicles bringing disease onto the yard.

The risk of infectious disease is low as long as there are good biosecurity measures in place to stop people/vehicles bringing disease onto the yard.
